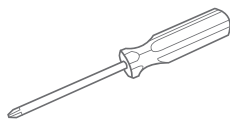


Cover Caps



TOOLS REQUIRED

Screwdriver



NOTE: For blinds with frame, the wand will always be attached to the back of the side sections of the frame. For blinds without a frame, the wand will be inside the headrail of the blind.

Sunwood: When the wand is wider than the blind, the wand will be sent as a separate package.

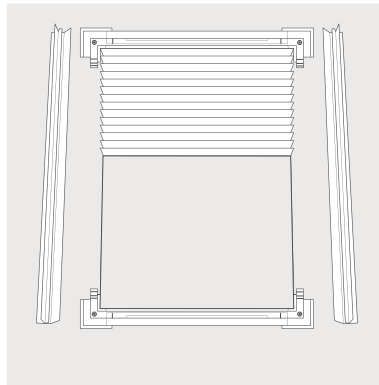
STEP 1

PUT THE FRAME TOGETHER

1.1

Lay all parts of the frame/blind out face down on a clean even surface.

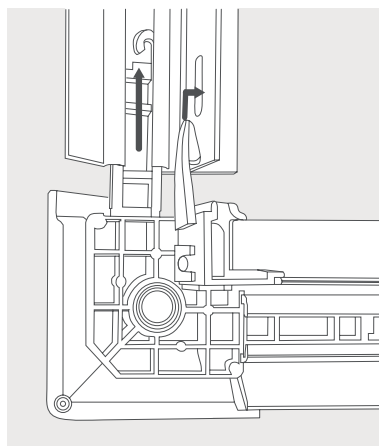
Your blind will be attached to the top section of the frame. The bottom frame section will be attached using the tension cords.

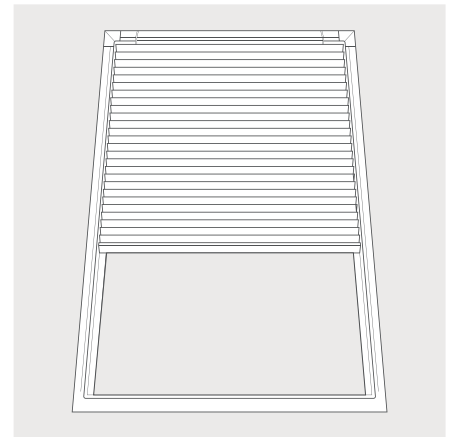
Slide the left-hand side of the frame on the bottom left-hand corner joint until the latch is secured inside the hole. Repeat the process on the top left-hand corner joint. Press cover caps into corner joints.

Follow the same procedure for the right-hand side of the frame ensuring cords do not become trapped.

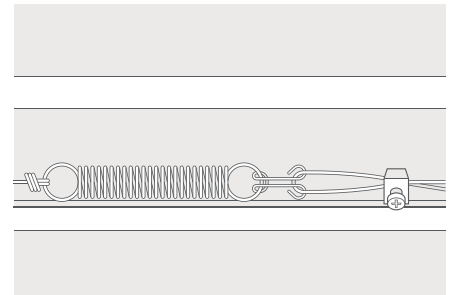

Your Perfect Fit frame and blind are ready to fit.



Attach the hook onto the spring. Test operation of blind. If the tension needs to be adjusted, loosen the screw in the locking ring. To increase tension make the cord shorter. To reduce tension make the cord longer and tighten the screw in the locking ring.

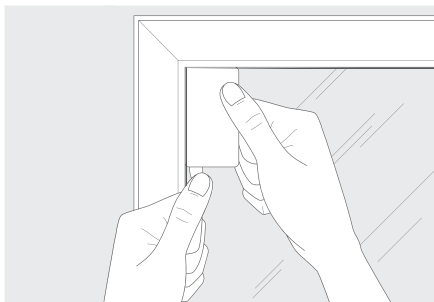
FITTING

ATTACH THE BRACKETS

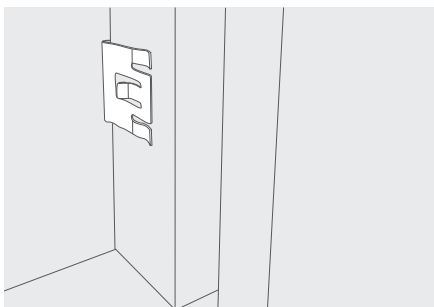
You need to push the brackets between your window pane and the rubber window seal. The brackets need to be lined up with the bracket hole positions on the Perfect Fit frame. Brackets are positioned approximately 85mm from the top and bottom.

TIP: You can use a credit/debit card as a template to find the correct position for the brackets. Place the card length ways along the side of the window in each corner, and line up the bracket with the end of the card as shown.



Press the flat edge of the bracket underneath the window seal. Bracket should be placed with the small tab facing outwards.

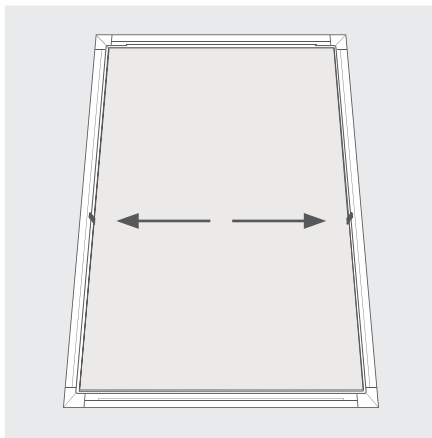
Align the brackets with the holes in the frame.

Fit any intermediate brackets accordingly. Two extra brackets will be supplied for blinds over 1100mm drop, these should be positioned approx. mid way down the drop of the blind, one on each side. These need to be lined up with the bracket hole positions on the Perfect Fit frame.

TIP: If you find that the brackets are difficult to place behind the window seal, you can use washing up liquid as lubricant on the flat part of the bracket. Once all the brackets are fitted, clean any excess from the window surface.

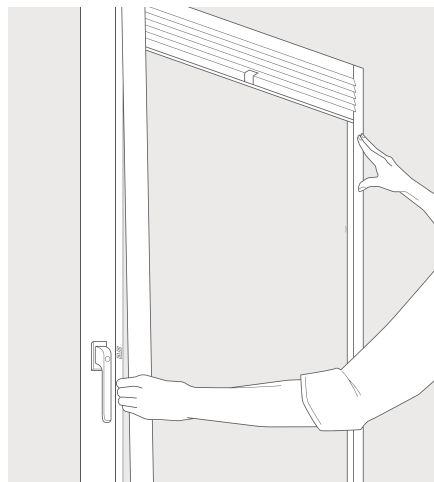


STEP 3

ATTACH THE FRAME & BLIND TO THE WINDOW

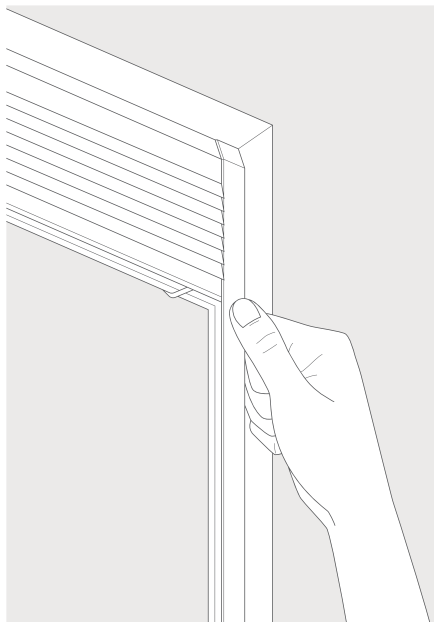

Line up the holes in the Perfect Fit frame with the brackets.

Firmly press the frame onto each bracket one side at a time.



Your frame and blind are now installed.

OPERATION INSTRUCTIONS

OPERATING YOUR BLIND

TO RAISE & LOWER THE BLIND

Simply raise and lower the blind to the desired position by firmly holding the handle.

Slats need to be open (horizontal) when raising or lowering the blind.

SLAT ANGLE

To adjust the angle of the slats twist the wand.

MAINTENANCE

The product is maintenance free, however we recommend that regular visual checks are completed to ensure that no components have been damaged, which could result in operating difficulties and/or cause a safety risk.

If any maintenance is required, we recommend that the work is carried out immediately by a reputable blind company.

WARNING

Young children can be strangled by loops in pull cords, chains, tapes and inner cords that operate the product.

To avoid strangulation and entanglement, keep cords out of the reach of young children. Cords may become wrapped around a child's neck. Move beds, cots and furniture away from window covering cords.

Do not tie cords together. Make sure cords do not twist and create a loop.
